Dear Parents/Guardians,

We were informed by the Ministry of Health (MOH) that a student from our school has tested positive for COVID-19 on 28 July 2021. The student is the household member of a confirmed case not from the school. The student was last in school on 19 July 2021 and was well. MOH has determined that there is no contact tracing required among school contacts as the student was not in school during the infectious period.

The school has been and will continue to keep staff and students safe through observing strict safe management measures such as cleaning high-touch surfaces and regularly disinfecting our premises. We have also conducted a thorough cleaning and disinfecting of the school premises. Temperature checks will continue to be carried out on all visitors to the school.

We urge all parents and students to continue playing their part by being socially responsible, to minimise the risk of COVID-19 infection in our schools. If feeling unwell, students should seek medical attention immediately, and not come to school. Parents are to keep their children at home if there are household members who are unwell with flu-like symptoms. Students can return to school if their household members are tested negative for COVID-19. This is important to keep our students in school safe.
